Thank you for your interest in the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe's Rosetta Stone. Native languages and cultures are at a critical point in their existence. We know culture and language is a core part of who we are.

The Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe has partnered with Rosetta Stone to create a language learning platform for our Ojibwe Language to empower our community, to maintain our identity, and to help us be successful.

Rosetta Stone software uses images, text, and sound to teach words and grammar by spaced repetition, without translation. Rosetta Stone calls its approach Dynamic Immersion.

- Improve your pronunciation using our exclusive speech recognition technology.
- Log in to learn anytime

Developing the Rosetta Stone Ojibwe not only serves as one part of our work to preserve our endangered language by creating an easily accessible, long-term language resource and normalizing the Ojibwe Language in our homes and communities - cultural frameworks that include learning native languages also benefit our communities:

- The Department of Economic and Social Affairs of the United Nations, in preparation of the Millennium Development Goals included culture as a significant driver and an enabler of sustainable development.
- Knowledge of Native American Culture/Language strengthens the ability of tribal members to overcome barriers.
- Expanding knowledge of cultural traditions and language supports healthy lifestyle choices. This contributes to self-esteem, pride in identity, and wellness which in turn contributes to workforce readiness.
- Traditional practice and language speaking helps to support those struggling with addiction or recovery.
- Youth who have knowledge of their Native language and participate in culture tend toward higher educational attainment and lower rates of substance misuse, suicide and other risk factors.

HOW TO REGISTER YOUR SCHOOL, ORGANIZATION OR OTHER GROUP MEMBERS

- 2. We will send you a spreadsheet that you can use to enter the information for your learners.
- 3. Please complete the spreadsheet to the best of your ability. Up to two people may be named administrators. Administrators can track learners' progress.

FAQS FOR SCHOOLS AND OTHER GROUPS

What is this project?

The Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe has partnered with Rosetta Stone to create a language learning platform for our Ojibwe Language to empower our community, to maintain our identity, and to help us be successful.

Native languages and cultures are at a critical point in their existence. The Mille Lacs Dialect of Ojibwe is an Endangered Language and must be preserved and revitalized in order to support prevention, recovery, and healthy lifestyle choices.

Project goals

- Preserve our endangered language.
- Support development of client self-esteem, pride in identity and wellness by offering life-long Ojibwe language and culture learning opportunities.
- Normalize Ojibwe Language and cultural use in the community.
- Support workforce development by creating life-long Ojibwe language learning opportunities.
- Support youth substance abuse prevention and support clients struggling with addiction or recovery.

How long will it take to complete the course?

It is expected to take three to eighteen months to complete each level, depending on the amount of knowledge you already have and the time you have to put into it. Level 1 would be consistent with a Freshman level high school or college course.

Can this be purchased through Rosetta Stone?

The Rosetta Stone Endangered Language Program was created in 2004 for use by endangered language communities engaged in language revitalization. Organizations, such as the Mille Lacs Band, that contract with the Endangered Language Program to develop custom software own the sales and distribution rights over their final product, allowing communities control over this language resource and respecting indigenous intellectual property rights. These versions are thus not marketed via the usual outlets such as bookstores or commercial websites.

How do I access Level 2?

Level 2 hasn't been released yet. You will need to re-register for each level.

Are licenses transferable?

No, they are not transferable.

Do licenses end?

Yes, it will end after 2 years; or 1 year of non-use. You can always re-register. Having your license revoked for non-use does not necessarily mean you will lose your progress.

Are the Rosetta Stone Fluency Builder and logins secure?

All data is encrypted both during transmission and while stored in the data center. Passwords are stored in a non-reversible salted hash. New users are forced to set their own passwords upon 1st access. Password hints are blocked on the login page.

No HTTP connections are accepted—all connections are forced to go through HTTPS. Rosetta Stone runs frequent vulnerability scans with some systems scanned 24x7. Rosetta Stone systems are SOC 2-audited annually. Note that Rosetta Stone does not send marketing emails to learners or administrative users.

Will this work on our devices?

Regarding mobile access, the Rosetta Stone Fluency Builder App is available from the Google Play Store (available for Android 6.0 or later) and Apple App Store (available for iOS 11.0 or later).

Regarding browser access, the minimum browser requirements are:

- A unique email address for each user
- High-Speed Internet connection
- Headset with microphone Earbuds that feature the microphone on the cord are typically not recommended, as
 the microphone may be too far from the mouth and will pick up ambient noise, background noise, etc. which
 disrupts the effectiveness of speech recognition.
